Dear Parents/Guardians:

Thank you for deciding to register your child(ren) in Religious Education. Please review the following directions **BEFORE** you begin the registration process.

- It is important to review all of your information before moving to the next screen. If you do not see a "Next" button, you have missed a required field.
- **There is no preview button before submission. If you would like a copy, please print the registration BEFORE submitting.**
- **You will need a printer to print the required 2020 Payment form** (see the link on the tuition calculation page in the registration form. Please send this form with your payment. **DO NOT** send cash in the mail.

**All agreements/policies are located on the St. Rose Religious Education website.**

Family information:

- If information is not applicable, please write N/A.
- For parent's names, please supply the father and mother (heads) of the present household.
- Please give us accurate email addresses as this will be the primary way St. Rose will contact you.
- If you are not already a registered member of St. Rose of Lima, there will be an additional **\$50 fee per student**. (Registered families support Religious Education by weekly contributions to the church.)

Grade 2, 7 and 8 Parents:

- There is a sacrament fee for students in Grade 2, 7 and 8. Please calculate your sacramental fees for ALL of your children, as per the tuition/fee table in the registration form, **it will not calculate multiple sacrament fees for the SAME grade (i.e. if you have twins).**
- Additional information is required when you register a grade 2 student. Please fill in the fields to the best of your ability. At a later date we will ask for a copy of the Baptismal Certificate.
- Birth City and State - This is the child's information, not parent.
- Biological parent information - this is required for our formal church registry.

Class Sessions:

- We are not offering Pre-K/Kindergarten classes this year.
- Classes are offered on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday and are one hour in length (**note Monday evening classes will also be one hour long**).
- If you have multiple children (i.e. twins) you would like in the same grade and class session, type in the appropriate number that correlates to your request for the class session (such as Sunday 9:15 a.m.)
- Please give thoughtful consideration to your choice for class sessions as there will be a very limited ability to change once the registration has been submitted.

Home School program:

- The Home School program is designed for families who feel it is in the best interest of their child to be taught at home by the parent or family member. The purpose of Home School is **not to be a convenience so that other activities can take precedence**. Your child's religious education should be considered the priority for living a full Catholic life.
- Please note the cost of Home School program is the same as on campus classes, as it covers books, grade-level materials, sacraments, and administrative/fixed costs of running Religious Education.

Catechist Discount for Tuition:

- We are very grateful for the gift of time and teaching that our volunteers give us each year. To thank our catechists for this time, we offer a 50% discount on the tuition **portion of the fee (after a \$35.00/child book fee is subtracted)**.
- If you decide that you will be a catechist for the coming year, please calculate your tuition, as per the tuition/fee table in the registration form, **it will not calculate the catechist discount.**
