

Saint Rose of Lima Religious Education Guidelines 2020/2021

Parental Agreement

As a parent of a child in our St. Rose Religious Education program, we ask that you fulfill the following requirements of our program. ***We take this agreement seriously and ask that you do the same.***

- The family will attend mass on a regular, weekly basis.
- Any missed lesson will be taught by a parent at home.
- Parents/guardians agree to adhere to all Religious Education policies as outlined in the Parent Handbook, including: arrival/drop-off and dismissal/pick-up procedures.
- **Drop-off and Pick-up procedures are outlined below.**
- A parent/guardian of a child who has a life-threatening food allergy requiring immediate use of an epi pen must remain in the building unless the child is able to self-administer (MD authorization required).
- Any changes of assigned class or session must be requested of, and authorized by, the Religious Education office only.

Class / Session Placement Reminders

- Classes are filled on a first come basis; spaces are limited by class size and the number of classes per grade per session.
- Monday 1 (M1) Session: Grades 7 and 8 are limited to one class (12 spaces) each.
- We do honor teacher requests ... AT THE DISCRETION OF THE RELIGIOUS EDUCATION OFFICE... *and* if you register by **July 15** . After that, we cannot honor requests.
- We do not honor requests to place your child with another particular child.

Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures

The safety of all children is our first priority; therefore, your cooperation and compliance with the following procedure is required to ensure their security:

If your child is in Grades PK, K, 1, 2, or 3: (in ALL Buildings)

You must park your car and accompany your child to and from the *classroom door* (so that they are under adult supervision at all times).

If your child is in Grades 4 through 8: (In the school or portable classrooms)

- **Drop-off:** parents may pull up into the horseshoe driveway to drop off their child, and students should exit the car from the right side.
- Parking barricades will be placed at the entrance of the horseshoe once classes have started. These barricades provide an area of safety for the children away from traffic.
- **Pick-up:** Parents are to park their car in the main parking lot and walk up to the sidewalk in front of the school to meet their children and escort them back to the car. **THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS.**

If your child attends class in the Holy Innocents building or Religious Ed. Office building:

- **Drop-off:** Parents may drop off children at the sidewalk in front of Holy Innocents. Children are to exit the vehicle on the side closest to the buildings. To avoid the back-up of incoming traffic, please do not linger in the driving lane.
- **Pick-up:** Parents are to park their car and **MUST** walk into the building to collect their child from the classroom and escort them back to their cars.
- This is a high traffic area at a busy time of the day; students **ARE NOT PERMITTED** to cross the traffic without an adult accompanying them.
