

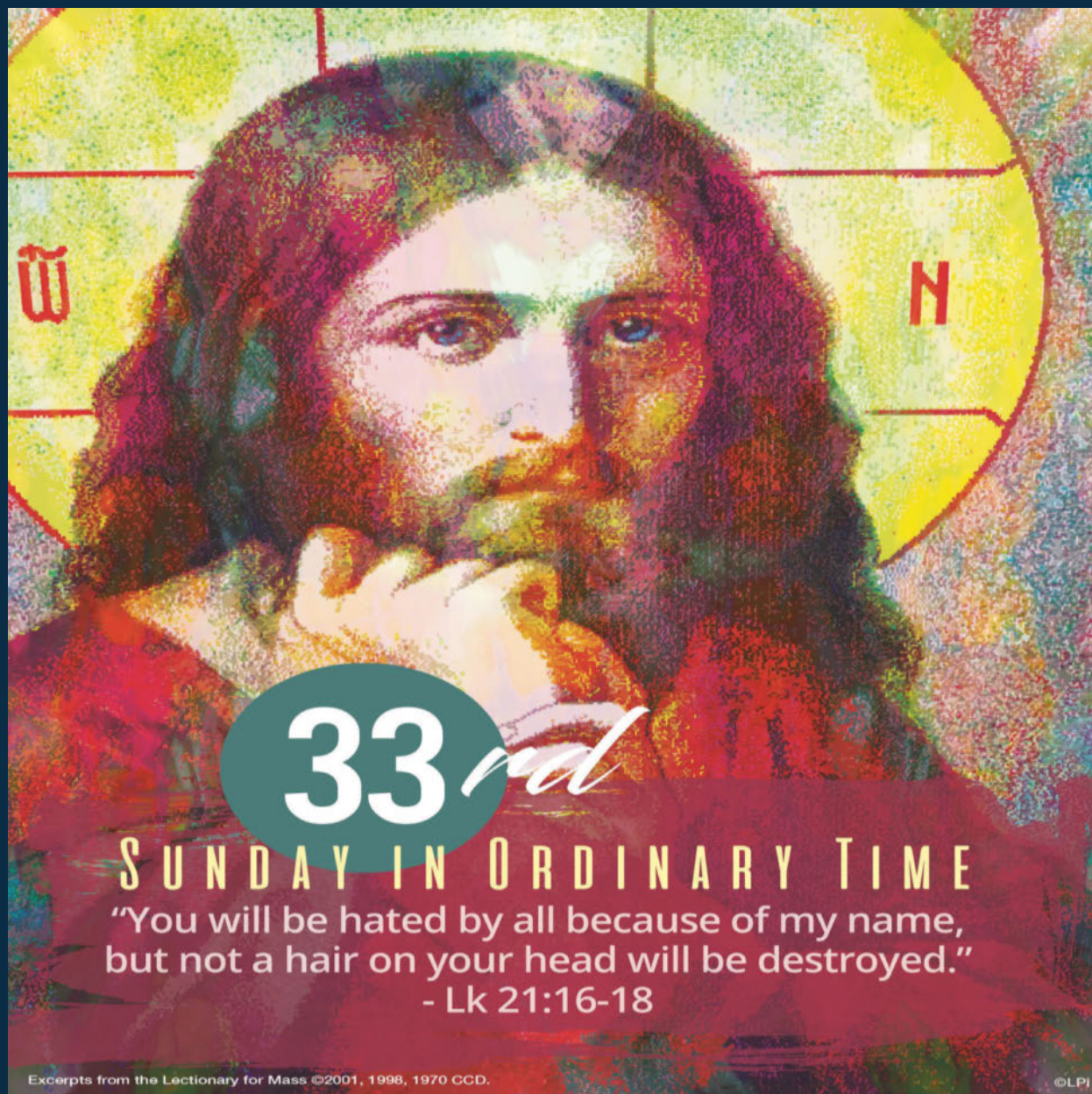

A Message from *Monsignor Bob***A PRAYER FOR VETERAN'S DAY**

God of peace,

This weekend we pause to thank the men and women of our country who have served us faithfully in the military. Whether or not they faced combat, they were willing to put their lives on the line for our rights and privileges. We are especially conscious of those who have been physically and emotionally damaged by their witness of the horrors of war and hate. We pray for their healing and for the strength and patience of their families. We also remember those who returned without a word of thanks, but were subjected to criticism and scorn. We have much for which to be grateful in this country in spite of the present situation with protests and uneasiness. Let us never forget those who have served and those who serve us today for their commitment to our country under God with the single purpose of liberty and justice for all, regardless of race, creed or orientation.

The memorial in honor of those who died during the Sandy Hook School tragedy is being dedicated and open to the public this weekend. It is a beautiful and peaceful way to remember 26 extraordinary teachers and children. Please take a moment over the next weeks to visit this very special memorial in Sandy Hook.

The annual **THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE** is being conducted this weekend. Unlike recent years, we are not collecting non-perishable goods. It is much more beneficial to the food pantries, soup kitchens and shelters we assist to provide them with gift cards to the local grocery stores so that they can purchase the perishable items that help make a Thanksgiving Dinner special as well as purchase items that may not have been donated. We will be collecting gift cards and cash/checks after all the Masses this weekend for this year's drive. The need is great with the state of the economy at the present time, so please be as generous as your means allow.

The annual **ADOPT-A-FAMILY** program is also underway. Thank you to all the families who "adopted" a family last weekend for the Christmas season. For those new to the parish, we ask you to donate a cash amount for the family you choose. We will then purchase gift cards that meet the needs of that family: groceries, gas, pharmacy, retail stores, etc. This enables them to do their own shopping and meet the needs of their family. Again, the need is great this year, and I am most grateful to those who are able to participate in this outreach.

The annual **CAROLINE'S TOY CHEST** is also open. We invite you to donate new, unwrapped toys. This collection is named in honor of Caroline Previdi, who lost her life in the Sandy Hook tragedy. Prior to her passing, each year she donated her own money to help us purchase toys for children in need. We continue her effort with this annual collection. It is a special way of keeping her memory alive in our hearts!

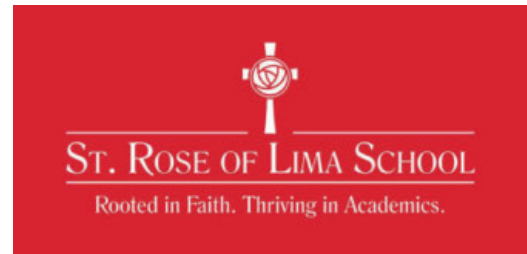
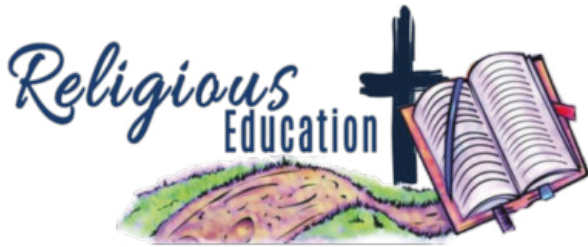
