A Message from *Monsignor Bob*

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

If ever the world needs vocations, it is now! We realize the rapid changes that take place in our world every day. In the midst of changes, we need to be able to rely on those things that never change to give us a sense of stability and help keep us grounded. Certainly our faith is the gift that enables us to do exactly that. But, we live in a world where faith is rapidly vanishing in the lives of many to the point that a country once based and founded in faith is turning atheistic. Where is God? As always, He is that constant presence. Even though many turn their back to God, He never turns away from us. How do we keep that truth alive in a changing society? We do it through faithful leaders who are willing to stand against the tides of contemporary society and stay firmly planted in the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and, by so doing, lead others in the same path. We need men and women to open their hearts and their lives to the service of others through vocations in ministry, especially priesthood, diaconate, and religious life. Today we as a Church throughout the world pray for vocations. Please join with your brothers and sisters in prayer that many will hear the call of the Lord through all the noise and chaos of the world and answer with "YES" as did Mary and all the great saints of our Church. And, please pray for those who are priests, deacons, religious sisters, and brothers for their continued commitment to face the challenges of the world in keeping faith alive and the Gospel as our guide in life.

Growing up, I remember a poem that was often used to talk about vocations. It is a bit dated for the world today, but it reminds us of the gift of priesthood: "The Beautiful Hands of a Priest"

We need them in life's early morning,
We need them again at its close;
We feel their warm clasp of friendship,
We seek them when tasting life's woes.
At the altar each day we behold them,
And the hands of a king on his throne
Are not equal to them in their greatness;
Their dignity stands all alone;
And when we are tempted and wander
To pathways of shame and sin,
It's the hand of a priest that will absolve us-
Not once, but again and again;
And when we are taking life's partner,
Other hands may prepare us a feast,
But the hand that will bless and unite us
Is the beautiful hand of a priest.
God bless them and keep them all holy
For the Host which their fingers caress;
When can a poor sinner do better
Than to ask Him to guide thee and bless?
When the hour of death comes upon us
May our courage and strength be increased.
By seeing raised over us in anointing
The beautiful hands of a priest!

Pray that when the Lord calls for workers for His harvest, the call will be heard. Offer this simple prayer...

God, our Father, You call each of us to use our gifts in the Body of Christ. We ask that You inspire those whom You call to priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life to courageously follow Your will. Send workers into Your great harvest so that the Gospel is preached, the poor are served with love, the suffering are comforted, and Your people are strengthened by the Sacraments. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

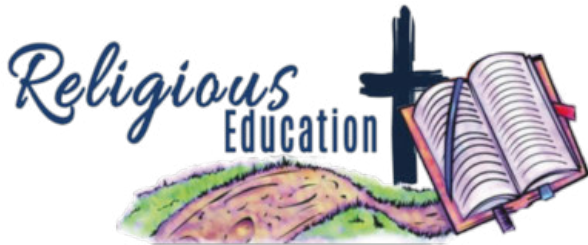

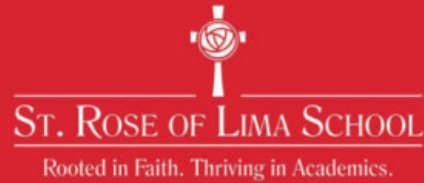

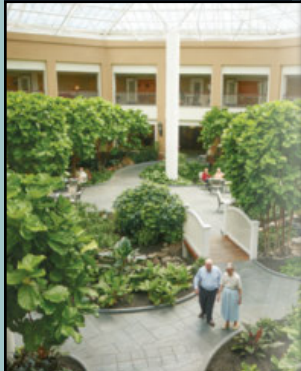
