A Message from *Monsignor Bob**I am the way and the truth and the life.**+ Jesus*

How often we have heard this beautiful statement by the Lord Himself. As we continue in our Easter celebration, we are called to ask ourselves if we truly believe this by the way in which we live our lives. Do we accept Jesus Christ as our guide through life, as the foundation of the truths we believe and as the source of all grace and blessing? In honesty, most of us cannot say that we do. We try our best to believe and live the Gospel, but the power of the world often blurs our vision and alters our conscience. So many other "life coaches" are put before us that Jesus is not our only guide in our decisions and choices. So many others are speaking truths that seem realistic and perhaps more appealing than the ones Jesus gives us, and we listen to them. So often we want to set the course of our own path through life rather than the one set by God Himself. And when we do, we know that failure is the result! The first believers and disciples had hard decisions put before them in order to follow Jesus. They feared for their lives and wondered if they would be treated as Jesus was; they feared alienation from their families and friends; they feared what these changes would do their lifestyles. As often as Jesus assured them, as He did in this weekend's Gospel, those fears remained. Jesus promised a share in His resurrection for those who were faithful and stayed the course He set for them. Yet, there was still hesitation. There were still questions to be answered. There was still proof they needed in order to remain faithful. Jesus simply said to them: "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me. In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be." As it was then, so it is now....we have those same questions, we want that same proof, we have those same doubts. The bottom line is....do we really believe? And do we accept Jesus as our way, our truth, and our life?

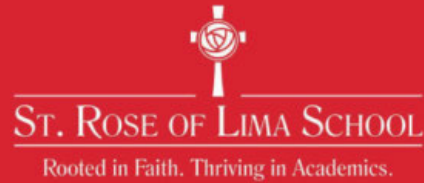
