

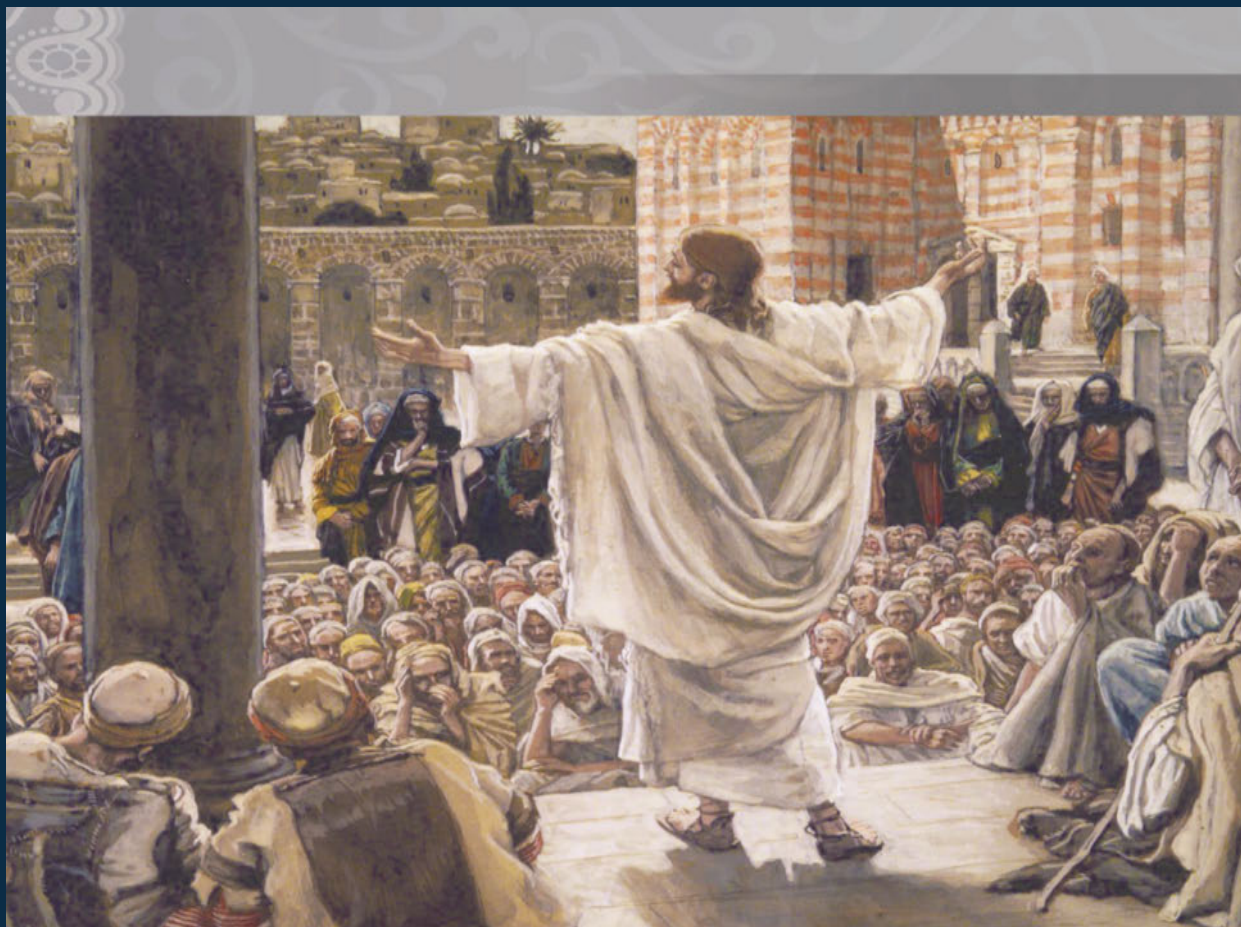

## A MESSAGE FROM *Father Peter*

### THE MARVEL OF OUR CARNIVAL
