

Did you know???

- > Each year our Religious Education program serves approximately 650+ students.
- > Though most students live in Newtown and Sandy Hook, some of our students come from Bethel, Brookfield, Danbury, Monroe, and Southbury.
- Our program had over 50 catechists last year. These catechists have been involved in Religious Education from one to 30 years, with many having children who attended or currently attend Religious Education classes at St. Rose.
- Our Classes are held in person on a weekly schedule utilizing St. Rose School, Holy Innocents Faith Formation Center, and the Religious Education meeting rooms.
- ➤ Our average class size is 12 students, and we offer instruction for grades K 8.

These are some of our costs that we incur each year, and must be covered by our tuition pricing:

Administrative Costs:

Salaries for our staff members and stipends for our grade level coordinators.

Overhead Costs:

Electricity, ventilation system, heat & A/C, phone, water, security system and maintenance/upkeep.
